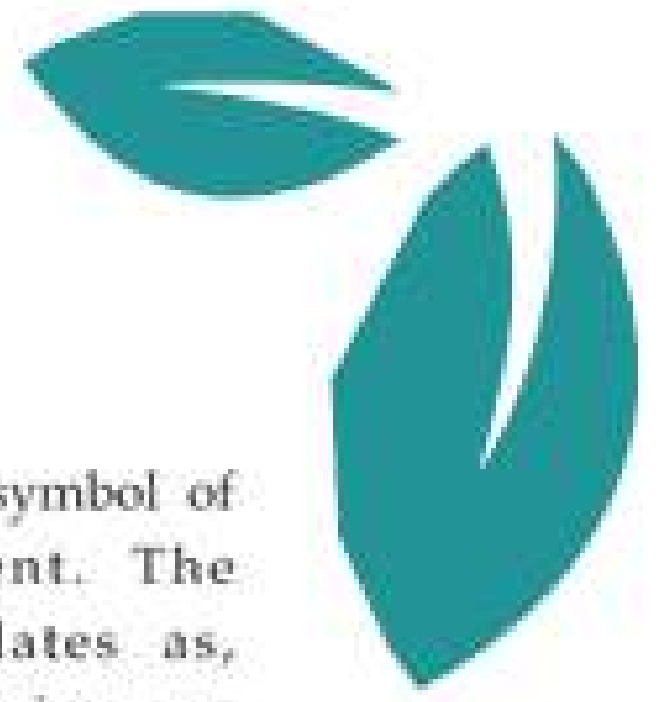

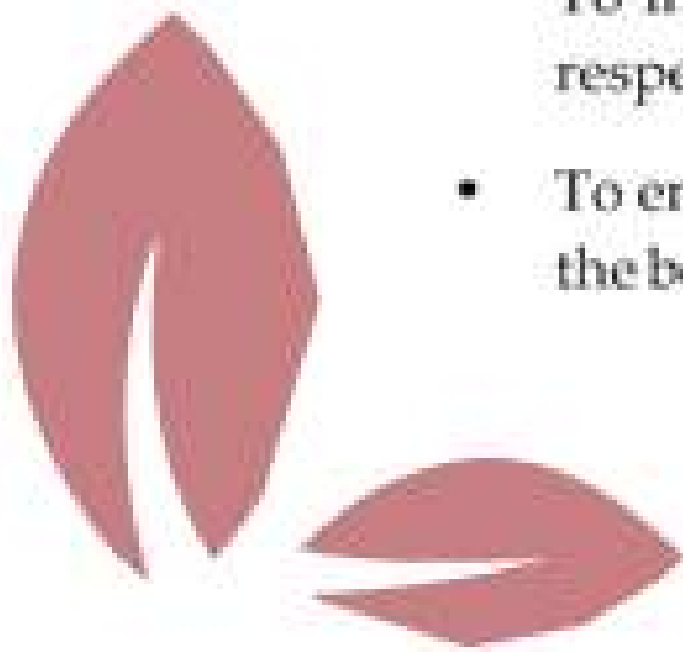
A swan is a symbol of enlightenment. The motto translates as, "O swan, give us knowledge and make us move constantly to newer heights of learning and excellence".

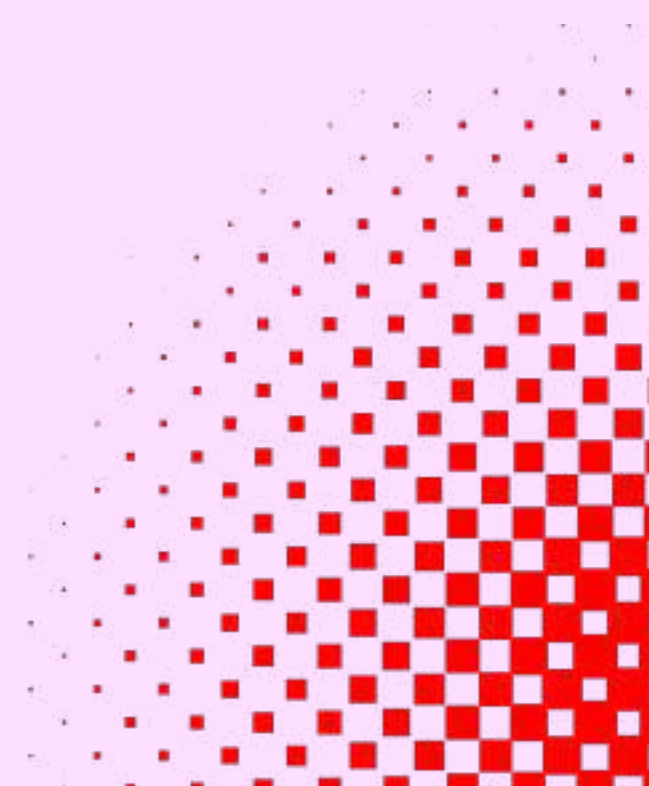

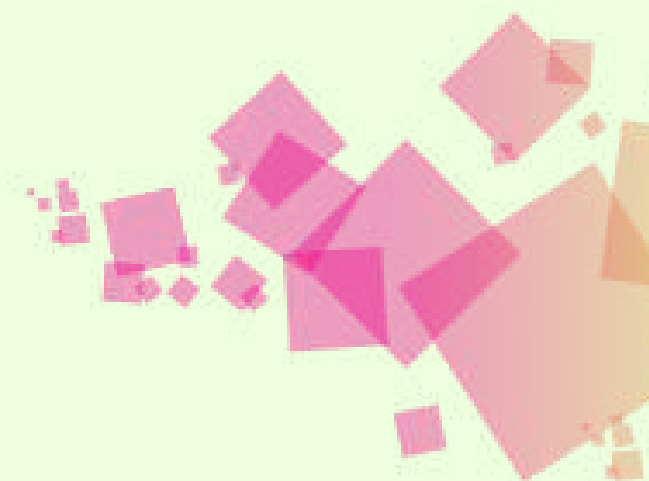

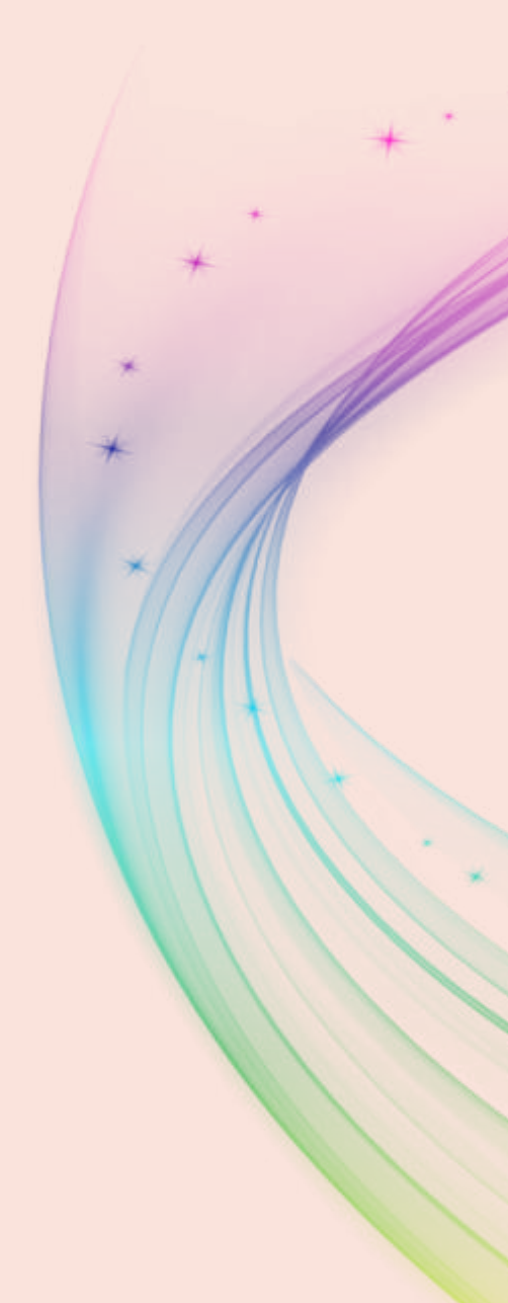
