Child Education Society, the apex body of Bal Bharati Public Schools all over the country, was set up in the year 1944 during the pre-independence era with an aim to preserve and foster Indian culture, heritage, tradition and ethos to uphold the vision of our elders. In order to achieve these objectives, it became obligatory for the Society to educate the young people. Thus, the Society was registered under the Registration of Societies Act, 1860. The affairs of the Society are managed by the Board of Management consisting of eminent educationists and social workers. It is headed by Mr. Nikhil Channa, a distinguished educationist and philanthropist, as the President of the Society. The Society, at present runs 27 institutions which include 14 core schools, 13 Project schools in collaboration with the Indian Railways and National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC). Bal Bharati Public Schools are progressive, co-educational English medium schools. Hindi enjoys its place of pride as the National Language in the school curriculum. Bal Bharati's educational philosophy is inspired by the maxim "आनोभ्रदः कृतवो यन्तु विश्वतः", that is, "Let noble thoughts come to us from all sides." The school provides comprehensive education keeping in view the country's rich heritage and cultural background, and provides a plethora of opportunities for the development of different facets of the child's personality. Besides academic excellence and intellectual development, the school endeavours to help each child discover and develop his/her innate talents and abilities. It seeks to instil in the children good habits, positive attitude and values such as honesty, unselfishness, self-respect, self-control, sense of duty, good manners, fair play, team spirit, dignity of labour, punctuality, compassion, freedom of mind and a rational and scientific approach. It is affiliated to the **Central Board of Secondary Education**, **Delhi**. Current roll strength of students is 2748. Twenty eight batches of Class XII (Science & Commerce) have so far passed out of this School.

In secondary department, students usual progress is through different grade levels i.e. from grade VI to grade IX. The curriculum at this level becomes more specialized and diverse, covering a wide range of subjects and preparing students for bright career options.

SENIOR SECONDARY

At the plus two level science, commerce and humanities streams are available. The Science stream offers physics, chemistry, Maths with Biology / Computer Science, Economics / Applied Mathematics. The Commerce stream offers Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics, Informatics Practice/Applied Mathematics & Standard Mathematics. The Humanities stream offers, English Political Science, Psychology, History and Economics. Students of our school have distinguished themselves by gaining admission to reputed institutions such as I.I.T. Delhi, Delhi



School of Planning & Architecture All India Institute of Medical Science, Delhi and other Medical and Engineering Colleges in different parts of the country.

RESULTS-2023

In class X, the school recorded 100% pass percentage. Percentage of first division is 96.2%. 13 instance of securing perfect score of hundred in various subjects. 67 students secured above 90%. The highest percentage in school is 98.2%.

In class XII, the school recorded 100% pass percentage. Percentage of first division is 97.4%. 3 instance of securing perfect score of hundred in various subject. 15 students secured above 90%, the highest percentage in school is 96.8% in commerce stream & 96.4% in science stream.

SCHOOL SYSTEM AND ACTIVITIES

PROCTORIAL BOARD

The School Proctorial Board comprises of the Principal, Vice Principal, Headmistresses of various departments, the Head Boy and the Head Girl along with Prefects. The Board looks after general discipline in the School.

There is a Students' Council comprising of two representatives from each class that meets regularly to discuss various aspects of discipline and the smooth running of the school.

PREFECTORIAL BOARD

The Prefectorial Board consists of School Captain, School Vice Captain, House Captains, House Vice Captains, Secretaries and Jt. Secretaries for literary, sports & cultural activities as well as student welfare projects. The prefects help maintain discipline and assist in organising various functions in the School.

LIBRARIES

ADMISSION TO PRE-SCHOOL

Weightage is given to children whose real brother or sister is studying in the School & wards of exstudents. Reservation of seats is as per Government guidelines.

between 8.00 and 12.00 noon from 4th July 2023.

Admission is subject to medical fitness and verification of birth certificate and proof of residence. Date for verification of the above documents will be given at the time of submission of application form.

The final list of selected candidates will be put up on the Notice Board and on the school Website.

MODE OF PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES

Quarterly Fee is to be paid online. However, at the time of admission the fee is to be paid by a bank draft in favour of 'Bal Bharati Public School'.

Fine for late payment of fee:

Rs. 100 for payment made after notified date till the 10th of the 2nd month of quarter.

Rs. 200 for payment made between the 11th of the 2nd month till the 10th of the 3rd month of the quarter.

Rs. 500 for payment made after the 11th of the 3rd month till the last day of the quarter.

The name of the student will be struck off the rolls if the fee is not paid by the end of the quarter and readmission fee will be charged.

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FOR (MONTESSORI) ADMISSION

The date of Fee deposit shall be displayed on the School's Website and Notice board. (In case of withdrawal of admission, the Admission Fee is non-refundable.)



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
