Access to various online digital courses and resources such as EMBIBE (PCBM) will help the students create digital portfolios and personalize their learning journey. The academic credits earned can be credited into Academic Bank of Credits as per the recent National Credit Framework under NEP 2020 which recognizes the pervasiveness and benefits of online learning.

Also, students can allocate more hours to **self-study**, enhancing their understanding and mastery of subjects. Additionally, they will save time and energy otherwise spent on commuting and transportation, allowing for a more focused and efficient study schedule.

The school has taken due cognizance of repeated requests from parents and students who sometimes find it challenging to balance self-study, competitive exam preparation, and CBSE Board exams.

Hybrid Classes for Class 11 will be conducted every Friday for four hours, starting from **July 15, 2024 on Microsoft Teams/Google Classroom (To be decided by school)**. On these days, students will follow a modified timetable for online sessions. As per CBSE norms, 75% attendance will be mandatory in both online and offline classes combined.
