Loud: Train, airplane.

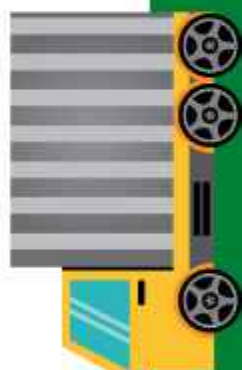
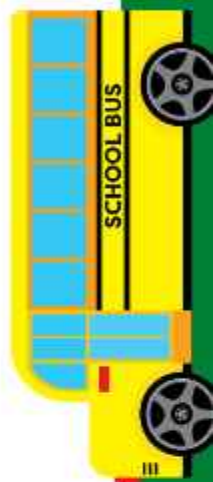
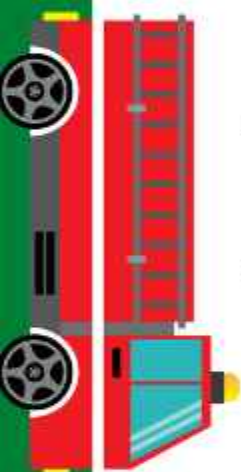
Soft: Bicycle, electric car.

Diwali
