










A Pan-India Chain







Pre-school and Pre-primary

The school follows the Montessori method of teaching at this stage. The pupils learn in an informal way with the help of specially designed apparatus under the supervision and guidance of trained and experienced teachers. Special attention is paid to facilitate the physical, mental, emotional and social growth of the child through a series of well-coordinated activities. Curriculum-based activities provide conducive learning ground to children and enhance their confidence. Beautiful and artistically displayed theme-based classrooms provide a stimulating and friendly learning environment to the students. Smart boards/ Interactive panels make learning joyful for curious little minds.

Primary

In the Primary Department, emphasis is given not only on acquisition of new knowledge but also on concept formation and application of knowledge in practical life situations. Stress is laid on 'learning by doing'. Children are given personal attention. They are exposed to pictorial informative books and audio-visual programmes which excite their interest in learning. Students are not unduly burdened with home assignments and are evaluated through their performance in various curricular and co-curricular activities.

Middle, Secondary and Senior Secondary

To ignite students' interest in learning, latest teaching-learning methodologies are followed. Self-discipline of the body and mind is practised through conscious and deliberate efforts. Performance of pupils is graded as per CBSE recommendations.



Laboratories

The school aims at developing the spirit of enquiry and a scientific temper in students from an early stage. In addition to customised computer-aided learning, projects, models, charts, PowerPoint presentations and other scientific educational aids, students learn through experiments and demonstrations in modern and well-equipped Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer, Geography and Mathematics laboratories.

Technologically-enabled classrooms

The school provides computer-aided learning management systems from Montessori to class XII. Pedagogically sound and visually rich curriculum resources are hereby mapped and customised to the needs of the students. AV aids provide tools and content for interactive self-paced learning for students, and interactive panels provide rich media presentations for teacher-led classroom learning.

Infirmary

The health centre is managed by qualified medical professionals. The centre is equipped with facilities to deal with day-to-day health problems of students. Regular medical check-ups are organised to ensure well-being of the students. A tie-up with reputed health agencies and hospitals provides services such as health insurance, service, medical care on campus.

School library

The school has well-stocked libraries with a good collection of books ranging from encyclopaedias to fiction and text books. The libraries are enriched with a collection of digital tools and resources used by the students for reference work. 'Book Week' encourages learning beyond text books. Thoughtfully graded books are made accessible to students in Senior and Junior libraries.

International dimension

Bal Bharati Public School, Brij Vihar is proud to be accredited as an IDS School since 2011. The IDS is an accreditation scheme developed by the British Council that recognizes the international dimensions in the school curriculum. The award is aimed at developing sustainable partnership internationally, providing professional development opportunities for teachers and encouraging international understanding among students through project works, exchange programme, video conferences, visit to museums and organising various competitions.









General Instructions For Admission

The registration for admission to Pre School & Pre Primary for the Session 2025-2026 is OPEN. Kindly read the Instructions given below very carefully:

1. Age of the child as on 31-03-2025 should be:

- 2. Kindly read the Instructions carefully before filling the form to avoid rejection.
- Kindly furnish the details of Online transaction of Rs. 500/- (NON REFUNDABLE) towards
 Registration Fee in the Online Form in the relevant column.
- Please provide at least one phone number of either (Father/Mother) in the column (s)provided for future communication.
- After submission, take a printout of the pdf file, for which link is available (as well as mailed to you). Please ensure that the form should be duly signed by the parent before submitting to the School office.
- 6. Fee for the current session (2024-2025) can be viewed under admission tab on the school website. For session 2025-2026 fee structure is yet to be decided. Kindly note that the school charges fees strictly as per the guidelines of Uttar Pradesh self-financed independent schools fee regulation act.
- For Sibling (OP)-Elder child of the parent should be studying in BBPS Brij Vihar only and attach the latest fee receipt with the form.
- For Alumni benefit- Passed both or either X& XII boards from the school (BBPS Brij Vihar)
 with minimum 5-year stay in the school.
- 9. Essential Documents to be attached with the form
- Birth Certificate of the child.
- Medical Certificate issued by RCI (Only for Children with Special Needs).
- Proof of Residence (Ration Card/Voter ID-Card/Telephone/ElectricityBill).
- Proof of Sibling (Self Attested copy latest fee slip).

- Proof of School Alumni(Self Attested copy of Class-XII or Class X certificate, SLC with minimum 5years of stay in school).
- Medical Fitness Certificate.
- Parents'ID Proof (Mother & Father)
- Parents' PAN Card (Mother & Father)
- Relevant Authentic Caste Certificate (SC/ST/OBC/EWS)
- Aadhaar Card of the child. (Self-Attested photocopy)
- 10. All communications will be done through mobile number & email id of the child's parent. The mobile number and the email id provided for registration will be blocked after submission of form and cannot be used for another submission.
- 11. It is mandatory to submit the Receipt, Admission Form along with the Annexure(both duly signed) by the parents, at the time of Admission of your ward.
- 12. Proof of residence should be in the name of the parents only.



The fixation of the revised fee structure is under consideration and will be notified as soon as it is finalised.

Mode of payment of school fee
